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RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE CAMPSITE LES VIOLETTES***

I- GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to enter, settle and stay on the campsite, you must be authorized by the Manager or his representative. The manager is responsible for the good maintenance and order of the campsite and for the respect of the application of the present internal regulations. The fact of staying on the campsite implies the acceptance of the provisions of these rules and the commitment to comply with them.

2. POLICE FORMALITIES

Any person having to stay at least one night in the campground must first present to the manager or his representative an identity document, to make the administrative formalities. Minors who are not accompanied by their parents will only be admitted with a written authorization from them.

3. INTALLATION

The tent or trailer and its equipment must be set up in the location indicated in accordance with the instructions given by the manager or his representative.

4. RECEPTION DESK

Opening hours are posted at the reception desk. At the reception desk you will find all the information about the services of the campground, information about the possibilities of refreshment, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the area and various addresses that may be useful. A complaints book or a special box for receiving complaints is available to users. Complaints will only be taken into consideration if they are signed, dated, as precise as possible and relate to relatively recent events.

5. FEES

Fees are payable in advance and are paid at the reception desk. The amount is posted at the entrance of the campground and at the reception desk. They are due according to the number of nights spent on the site. Campground users are asked to notify the reception office of their departure the day before. Campers intending to leave before the opening time of the reception office must pay their fees the day before. No refunds will be made for early departures.

6. NOISE AND SILENCE

Users of the campground are urged to avoid any noise or discussion that might disturb their neighbors. Sound equipment should be adjusted accordingly. Door and trunk closures should be kept as quiet as possible. The

silence must be total between 23 hours and 07 hours.

7. VISITORS

After being authorized by the manager or his representative, visitors may be admitted to the campground under the responsibility of the campers receiving them. The camper may receive one or more visitors at the reception. If these visitors are allowed to enter the campground, the camper who receives them may be required to pay a fee, insofar as the visitor has access to the services and/or facilities of the campground. This fee

is posted at the entrance to the campground and at the reception desk. Visitors' cars are not allowed in the campground. Visitors are not allowed to enter the campsite's aquatic area.

8. TRAFFIC AND PARKING OF VEHICLES

Within the campground, vehicles must travel at a limited speed of 10 kilometers per hour. Traffic is forbidden between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. Only vehicles belonging to campers staying in the campground may be driven in the campground. Parking must not impede traffic or prevent the arrival of newcomers.

9. MAINTENANCE AND APPEARANCE OF THE INSTALLATIONS

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite and its facilities, especially sanitary facilities; it is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in the gutters. Caravanners must empty their waste water into the facilities provided for this purpose. Household garbage, waste of any kind, papers, must be deposited in the garbage cans. Washing is strictly forbidden. The hanging of laundry is tolerated until 10 am on the condition that it is very discreet and does not disturb the neighbors. It should never be done from the trees. Plantations and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden for the camper to put nails in the trees, to cut branches, to make plantations. It is also forbidden to mark out the location of an installation by personal means, nor to dig the ground. Any damage to the vegetation, fences, grounds or facilities of the campground will be charged to the person responsible.

The site that will have been used during the stay must be maintained in the state in which the camper found it at his entry in the premises.

10. SECURITY

a) Fire

Open fires (wood, coal, etc.) are strictly forbidden. Stoves must be kept in good working order and not be used in dangerous conditions. A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

b) Flight

The management is responsible for items left at the office and has a general obligation to monitor the campground. Campers are responsible for their own facilities and must report the presence of any suspicious persons to the manager. Campground users are asked to take all the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.

<u>11.</u> GAMES

No violent or disruptive games may be played near the facilities. Children must always be under the supervision of their parents.

12. DEAD GARAGE

Dead parking is possible within the limits of available spaces and for a limited time. Please ask at the reception. Dead parking on the site is not allowed.

13. DISPLAY

These rules and regulations are posted at the entrance to the campground and at the reception desk. It is given to the customer on request.

14. VIOLATION OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

If a resident disturbs the stay of other users or does not respect the provisions of the rules, the manager or his representative may, orally or in writing if he deems it necessary, give notice to the latter to stop the disturbance. In case of serious or repeated infringement of the rules and regulations and after formal notice by the manager to comply, the latter may terminate the contract without any compensation. In the event of a criminal offence, the manager may call in the police.

II SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Equipment:

A pitch is designed to accommodate one piece of equipment: tent, caravan or motor home.

All supplements: additional tent, additional person, visitor, additional vehicle, car, motorcycle, trailer, pet, ... must be declared at the reception, they are priced according to the season at the daily rate or corresponding package.

MISCELLANEOUS:

The user will take out insurance against fire, explosion, rental risks and recourse and must provide the reception desk with an up-to-date certificate.

The user will not be allowed to organize commercial activities on the site. Sub-letting is

forbidden under penalty of immediate exclusion from the campsite.

<u>Animals :</u>

Dangerous dogs are forbidden (see municipal decree concerning 1st category dogs.) Dogs and other animals must never be left at large. They must not be left on the campsite, even locked up, in the absence of their owners, who are civilly responsible for them.

Animals are not allowed in the sanitary facilities. The health booklet with up-to-date rabies vaccinations must be presented at all times.

Animals are not allowed in the rental units and for all camping stays longer than two weeks.
